100Green Billing Explainer

What will my bill show?

Tariffs: As a member of your Energy Local Club you pay two sets of prices for power - the 'match tariff(s)' for electricity used when power is being generated locally by your club generator(s) and the 'time of use tariffs' (TOUT)* for extra electricity not available in the club.

The bill will show how much power you have used on each tariff, depending on the time of day and availability of local power.

Standing charge: You will pay a daily standing charge*.

**The TOUT and standing charge for your club are set by 100Green according to your regional electricity zone.*

Monthly fees: Subject to the arrangements decided by your club, you will also be charged a monthly fee which normally comprises:

- £5 a month for 100Green (£60 a year total)
- £0.67 a month which is split between your Club (£2 a year total) and Energy Local CIC (£6 a year total).

How will I receive my bill?

Your bill can be found on your 100Green account and you will be emailed notifications.

What will my bill look like?
